

We will resume worship indoors on Sunday, June 7, with the following guidelines:

- Before you decide to join us, **please make sure you are not running a temperature or exhibiting any other symptoms** of illness.
- **Masks are required when in the building.** Arriving and departing, please maintain appropriate distances with others, refrain from physical contact.
- Please pick up a **disposable/take-along service bulletin**. On a communion Sunday, help yourself to one of the **single-unit communion cups**.
- We have an **offering station** where you may make a contribution before, after, or during the anthem part of the service – continue to maintain distance with others as you do so.
- **Seating is in every other pew** – within a pew, please seat yourself in family units, distanced 6 ft. from anyone else in the same pew.
- There will be **no singing aloud** during the service; hymns will be played and the lyrics will be in your handout so that you can read along and reflect on this as a musical/poetic prayer.
- **Use common sense and the practices you've been learning** during the pandemic – we want this to be a safe space and time for everyone.

Keep in mind:

- Weekly cleaning will have been done before we gather.
- **There is hand sanitizer available as you enter and wipes available: please use liberally, and/or bring your own.**
- There will be **no hymnals or Bibles in the racks: you may carry your own Bible, of course**, but the readings will be in the service bulletin.
- **Windows and/or doors will remain open for air circulation** during the service.
- Please **do not leave bulletins, communion cups, or anything else in the pews; dispose of or take along anything you bring in.**
- We will have **masks available** if you forget your own: if you take one, please take it home.
- There is **no childcare, nor a children's story** at this time, tho' children are welcome to sit with families and bring busy work or snacks for themselves.
- **If you are a visitor or infrequent/non-member, we ask you to fill out a contact note so that in the unlikely event we need to follow a reported case you may be contacted.**

ALSO: We have a projected capacity of 64 persons in the Sanctuary at this stage, and do not anticipate that being at issue for regular Sunday worship.
